Title: "More than Meets the Eye"

This week we wrapped up our study of Daniel. In closing Pastor Peppy offered four points of application. Over the course of this study we have taken a look at each of these in varying degrees and from different perspectives. This week we are going to revisit the first three with a special focus on thinking about the big picture of the Bible and the personal impact of each statement on our daily lives. The applications for us were:

1. God's Word is true; trust it.
2. God's judgement is sure; talk it.
3. God's command is purity; walk it.
4. King Jesus has promised to return; watch for it.

1. What parts of God's word do you find it the most difficult to trust? Why?

How can we grow in our faith when we find ourselves out of sync with a portion of God's Word?

2. If we say we are positive that God's Word is the final word on all subjects, then why do we so often shy away from speaking the truth to our neighbors and friends?

Why are we so timid about sharing our faith if we know we are right?

How can we overcome obstacles to being the witnesses God calls us to be?

3. What are some of the moral teachings in God's word that we find the most difficult to obey and walk in continually?

How can we grow in those areas?
