

CONNECT Group study questions for April 21, 2019

Title: "Evidence that Demands a Verdict"

1. The Sermon on Easter was about the resurrection of Jesus. Which of the reasons Pastor Peppy offered to believe in the resurrection do you find the most compelling and persuasive? Why?

2. Pastor Peppy issues us a challenge to invite at least one person to our Easter service so they might hear the gospel. Take some time in your group to share your experience with this challenge. Who did you invite? How did you pray? How did it go?

3. Take some extended time at the end of your group to pray for each of the people your group invited. Pray for them by name.

- Pray that God would continue to do a work in the hearts of those who were invited but didn't come. God isn't finished with them yet. He loves them too much to give up.

- Pray for those who came to church but didn't respond. Pray that our kindness, our worship, and Peppy's sermon might bring them to faith in Christ by the power of the Holy Spirit.

- Pray that those who came and were saved would come back and be disciplined and grow in their faith.

- Pray that our church would be changed by the experience, and pray that we would increasingly grow to be on the mission that God is on in the world.
