The way we handle our money is actually a spiritual issue!

Where do you base your security?
Your money or your Savior? (Heb 13:5-6)

You cannot serve God and money. (Matt. 6:24)

Four Truths to Getting a Grip on Your Money:

I. Plant: You want to invest in what will give you the greatest probability of return. (Psalm 50:14, 15, 23)

Note: When you invest in God's kingdom, God invests in you!

Note: If you don't bring God the tithe, He will charge you interest on what you did not bring. (Lev. 27:30-31)

II. Plan: Develop a budget.

What do we call a financial plan? It's called a budget (Prov 21:5)

III. Prioritize : You must understand the difference between needs, wants, and desires.

3 Needs: (1 Timothy 6:8)

1. Food
2. Clothes
3. Shelter
