## The Temptation of Fame, Fortune and Power"

Esther 1:1-22 September 7, 2014

The Book of Esther is an epic account of the sovereignty of God.

Ahasuerus is not his real name, it's actually his title.

Question: What was the purpose of Ahasuerus' 6-month party?

Answer: The purpose was to show off his wealth and

power (v.4)

Question: Is drinking alcohol wrong?

Answer: I can find no prohibition in Scripture that says drinking alcohol is wrong.

Verses to make you think before you drink:

Timeless Principle: Getting drunk is wrong!

I. Ephesians 5:18

- 2. Galatians 5:21
- 3. 1 Cor 6:10

Timeless Principle: Never be a stumbling block

4. Romans 14:13

Triple offense concerning Vashti's refusal to obey the king:

A woman  $\underline{\text{challenging}}$  the authority of a man.

A wife disobeying the orders of her husband.

A subject defying the command of the king.

Question: Was Vashti right in her decision?

Answer: Absolutely

The word "show" means being exposed.

"And let the king give her royal position to another who is better than she." (v.19) This verse is the <u>sovereignty</u> of God! Vashti will now exit the scene and Esther will now enter.
