"Turning Defeat into Victory" Joshua 7, 8 August 16, 2015

Four reasons for the defeat at Ai:

Reason #1: Overconfidence - They lost this battle because they thought they could handle it on their own without God. (Joshua 7:2,3)

Reason #2: <u>Assumption</u> - They lost this battle because they assumed that God would support their plan. (Joshua 7:4,5)

Reason #3: <u>Negligence</u> - They lost this battle because they failed to go to God when their plan "went south." (Joshua 7:6)

Reason #4: <u>Disobedience</u> - They lost this battle because there was "secret sin" in their camp. (Joshua 7:1)

Five principles on how to turn defeat into victory:

Principle #1: We need to remember that God <u>never forsakes</u> His children no matter how badly they <u>mess up.</u> (Joshua 8:1)

Principle #2: We need to <u>learn</u> from our <u>mistakes</u> and not <u>repeat</u> them. (Joshua 8:1)

Principle #3: When you're <u>defeated</u> by a <u>faith test.</u> recognize that you're going to be required to <u>repeat</u> the test again. (Joshua 8:1)

Principle #4: We need to remember that recovery of lost ground is always <u>painful</u> and <u>costly.</u> (Joshua 8:30-35)

Principle #5: We need to remember that following any <u>victory.</u> we need to give the <u>glory</u> to the Lord. (Joshua 8:30-35)
