## "Risking It All" Luke 2:8-20 December 20, 2015

Introduction: Luke 2:8-14

On the fringes of society (Luke 2:8)

- 1. Shepherds were nobodies.
- 2. Shepherds were considered to be <u>unreliable</u> and often <u>untruthful</u>.
- 3. Shepherds lived outside.
- 4. Shepherds were poor.

God's surprising first choice to hear about the Christmas story: (Lu 2:8-14) Who was God's first choice to receive the Christmas announcement? The shepherds

- IV. The difficulty of the shepherds decision (Lu 2:15-20)
  - 1. The shepherds had to <u>decide</u> what to do with the <u>information</u> they <u>received</u>.
  - 2. Shepherds have one all-important job: to stay with the sheep.
  - 3. For a shepherd to leave his sheep is like a soldier leaving his guard post.
  - 4. For these shepherds to leave their sheep would be a significant risk.

What decision did the shepherds make? (Luke 2:15.16) The shepherds <u>risked it all</u> to come to Jesus.

The shepherds next decision (Lu 2:17-20)

What did the shepherds do next after finding Jesus in Bethlehem lying in a manger?

They started testifying what they had been told concerning Jesus. (Lu2:17-20)
