"Forward March" Genesis 5:21-27 January 10, 2016

HERE THERE

Where you are right now in your relationship with Christ.

Renewed passion for Christ

Leadership is moving people from HERE to THERE.

Enoch had one major claim to fame: (Gen 5:24a)

Enoch walked with God.

What does it mean "to walk with God"? It means that you are enjoying intimate fellowship with Him.

Challenge: If you are going to walk with God and have the kind of intimate fellowship with God that Enoch did, you are going to have to take the time to do it.

Question: What is a "quiet time"? A "quiet time" is where you spend time <u>walking with God</u> and <u>talking with God</u>.

Note: Genesis 5:24 says that Enoch walked with God; God did not walk with Enoch. Why is this important? It's important because God was not going Enoch's way; Enoch was going God's way.

Note: Genesis 5:24 also says that Enoch walked **with** God. What does that mean? It means he did not walk <u>ahead</u> of God and he did not walk <u>behind</u> God, he just walked <u>with</u> God.

How long did Enoch walk with God? (Gen 5:21,22) 300 years.

What does Methuselah's name mean? "When he is dead, it will be sent." What is the "it" referring to in Methuselah's name? This was a prophecy concerning the flood that God was going to send.

When did the flood come? (Gen 7:11)

Why did Methuselah live longer than anyone else? Because he illustrated how <u>patient</u> and <u>long-suffering</u> God is concerning His judgment.

What is one more feature about Enoch's life?

Enoch is only one of two men who never <u>saw</u> or <u>experienced death.</u>
