"Counting Sheep" John 10:1-18 May 8, 2016

Two different kinds of sheepfolds:

- 1. A village sheepfold
- 2. A countryside sheepfold

Five marks of the True Shepherd:

Mark #1: The True Shepherd enters by the door to the sheepfold. (v.1, 2)

Mark #2: The gatekeeper opens the door for the True Shepherd. (v.3a)

Mark #3: The sheep recognize the True Shepherd's voice. (v.3b)

Mark #4: The True Shepherd calls <u>his sheep by name.</u> (v.3c)

Mark #5: The True Shepherd <u>leads</u> and his sheep <u>follow</u> him. (v.3d, 4)

Question: Why would the shepherd lie down at the entrance of the countryside sheepfold? (two reasons):

- 1. To keep the sheep in!
- 2. To keep the <u>predators out!</u>

Jesus is the door:

- 1. He is the door of salvation. (v.9)
- 2. He is the door to our spiritual growth and nourishment. (v.9)
- 3. He is the door to our spiritual <u>satisfaction</u>. (v.10b)
