Five Destructive Steps

Romans 1:24-32 September 17, 2017

What phrase is used three times in this passage?

- v. 24- "God gave them over."
- v. 26- "God gave them over."
- v. 28- "God gave them over."

The phrase means <u>"abandoned by God"</u> where God removes His restraining grace and allows people to reap what they have sown or suffer the consequences of their willful wrong choices.

Three stages of God's abandonment:

Stage #1: Widespread sexual immorality. (v. 24, 25)

Stage #2: Open homosexuality (v. 26, 27)

Three facts concerning homosexuality from a Biblical perspective:

- 1. Homosexuality is a willful choice not a biological imperative. (v. 26, 27)
- 2. Widespread homosexuality is a specific sign of God's abandonment. (v. 26, 27)
- 3. Homosexuality is a <u>sin</u> but it's a <u>sin</u> that <u>can be forgiven</u>. (1. Cor 6:8-11)

What happened to these homosexuals in I Cor 6:9-11?

They were homosexuals. They are now Christians.

How can you be an effective witness in this upside-down culture?

(two things must be paired together)

Moral conviction and Christ-like compassion

Stage #3: Unrestrained evil (v. 28-32)

What flows out of a pornographic, homosexual, depraved culture?

Unrestrained evil

Paul outlines three things in v. 32 that happens when people have completely and decisively turned away from God:

- 1. They know what they are doing is wrong.
- 2. They do the wrong anyway.
- 3. They praise other wrong doers.

Three things we can do to influence our culture to turn the tide:

- 1. Pray. (2. Chronicles 7:14)
- 2. Share the gospel. (Romans 1:16)
- 3. Live the gospel. (Matthew 5:16)
