## Objections Overruled Romans 3: 1-8 October 8, 2017

The whole human race is under the and of God.

Fact #1: The Gentiles are sinners. (v. 18-21)

Fact #2: The moralists are sinners. (v:1-16)

Fact #3: The <u>religious Jews</u> are sinners. (v. 2:17-29)

Three objections to Paul's teaching:

Objection #1: If I am a sinner, then why be religious? (3:1,2)

Then what advantage has the Jew? Or what is the benefit of circumcision? Great in every respect.

First of all, that they were entrusted with the oracles of God. (Ro 3:1.2)

Objection #2: If I am a sinner, does that mean God won't keep His promises? (v. 3,4)

What then? If some did not believe, their unbelief will not nullify the faithfulness of God, will it? (Ro 3:3,4)

Objection #3: If I am a sinner, then why even <u>bother</u> being <u>good</u>? (v. 5-8)

But if our unrighteousness demonstrates the righteousness of God, what shall we say? The God who inflicts wrath is not unrighteous, is He? (I am speaking in human terms.)

May it never be! For otherwise, how will God judge the world? But if through my lie the truth of God abounded to His glory, why am I also still being judged as a sinner?
And why not say (as we are slanderously reported and as some claim that we say). Let us do evil that good may come? Their condemnation is just. (Ro 3:5-8)
