Romans 4:16-25

How was Abraham saved?

In verses 1-8, Paul proves that Abraham was not saved by good works.

In verses 9-12. Paul proves that Abraham was not saved by circumcision.

In verses 13-15, Paul proves that Abraham was not saved by keeping the Law.

So. how was Abraham saved? Abraham was saved by God's grace through faith. (Gen 15:6)

I. The expression of Abraham's faith

What does "it" refer to in verse 16?

"It" refers to salvation.

Saving faith does 2 things:

1. Saving faith brings us into the favor of God. (v.16a)

Important note: The only way to God is grace and the only way to grace is faith.

- 2. Saving faith brings us into the family of God. (v.16b)
- II. Characteristics of saving faith—What are the key characteristics of saving faith?
 - 1. Saving faith is in the Person of God. (v17)
 - 2. Saving faith is in the Promise of God. (v.19,20)
 - 3. Saving faith is in the Power of God. (v.21,22)
- III. Applications of saving faith
 - 1. The object of our faith is the God who raised Jesus from the dead. (v.24)
 - 2. The objective of saving faith is to be saved from sin and to be justified. (v.25)
