

Whose Slave are You?
Romans 6:15-23 ESV

Things people are enslaved to:

1. Some are slaves to their work.
2. Some are slaves to things, possessions and temporal stuff.
3. Some are slaves to pleasing others.
4. Some are slaves to the god of self. (Narcissists)

Paul's basic answer to the two questions:
"By no means!" (Ro 6:2a, 15b)

Paul's explanation to the second question: (2 parts)

1. The daily choice between two kingdoms. (v. 16-18)
There are two kingdoms in this world: the kingdom of sin and the kingdom of God.
2. Paul's explanation as to why the Kingdom of God is always the right choice.
(v. 19-23)

"For just as you once presented your members as slaves to impurity and to lawlessness."
(v.19b)

"Your members" has to do with parts of your body.

Question: What does sin pay?

1. Slavery (v. 19, 20)
2. Shame (v. 21)
3. Death (v. 23a)

Question: What does God pay? (v. 19-23)

1. Righteousness (v. 19)
2. Sanctification (v. 19)
3. Eternal life (v. 23)
