Free from the Law Romans 7:1-6 (ESV)

The believer has been set free from sin so he can live his life unto the Lord.

Paul uses three images:

- 1. Baptism (Ro 6:1-14)
- 2. Slavery (Ro 6:15-23)
- 3. <u>Marriage</u> (Ro 7:1-6)

Paul's axiom concerning the law:

The Law has no jurisdiction over a <u>dead</u> person.

Paul's analogy:

Remarriage is <u>permitted</u> after the <u>death</u> of a spouse. (v. 2, 3)

Paul's application:

Our death in Christ releases us from the Law and allows us to be joined to Christ. (v.4)

- 1. We died to the Law.
- 2. We are now joined to Christ.

Our Old Relationship (B.C.)

- 1. We bore fruit for death. (v.5)
- 2. We served in the oldness of the letter. (v.6)
- 3. We served under the jurisdiction of the Law.
- 4. Our sinful passions were aroused by the Law.

Our New Relationship (A.D.)

- 1. We bear the fruit of the Spirit. (v.4)
- 2. We now serve in newness of the Spirit. (v.6)
- 3. We are dead to the Law. (v.4)
- 4. Now we have been released from the Law. (v.6)
