True Confessions Romans 7:14-25 (NASB)

- Confession #1: He confesses that the <u>Law</u> is <u>spiritual</u> and his <u>flesh</u> is <u>sinful</u>. (v. 14)
- Confession #2: He confesses that <u>he does not do</u> what he knows he <u>should be doing</u> and <u>he does do</u> what he knows <u>he should not be doing</u>. (v. 15-17)
- Confession #3: He confesses that <u>nothing good</u> dwells in his <u>fleshly nature</u>. (v. 18-20)
- Confession #4: He confesses to the <u>struggle</u> he has with the <u>two forces</u> within. (v. 21-23)
- Confession #5: He confesses that he is a <u>wretched man</u> in <u>desperate</u> need of a <u>Deliverer</u>. (v. 24)
- Confession #6: He confesses that his <u>deliverance</u> will come through the great <u>Deliverer</u>, <u>Jesus Christ</u>. (v. 25)
