Holy Spirit Perks Romans 8:9-17

Three words to remember about the Holy Spirit:

- 1. Person The Holy Spirit is not an it or a thing.
- 2. Possession Every Christian possesses the Holy Spirit.
- 3. <u>Position</u> The Holy Spirit desires first place in your life. *Note*: One mark of genuine Christianity is the indwelling of the Holy Spirit.

Two implications of the Holy Spirit living in you:

- 1. The Holy Spirit gives you a brand new life. (v.10)
- 2. You have the promise of a <u>future resurrection</u>. (V.11)

Note: The Apostle Paul called believers <u>sons of God</u>" and c<u>hildren of God</u>". *Note*: Abba means "<u>daddy</u>" or "<u>papa</u>".

Five benefits of a believer:

- 1. You get personal guidance from the Holy Spirit. (v.14)
- 2. You have fearless intimacy with God. (15a)
- 3. You have the right to call God "Father". (v.15b)
- 4. You have inward assurance of belonging to God. (v.16)
- 5. You are an heir of God and a fellow heir with Christ. (v. 17)

Two important truths about the Holy Spirit:

- 1. The believer owes <u>nothing</u> to the <u>flesh</u>. (v.12)
- 2. The believer owes the Holy Spirit everything. (v.13)

Question: How do you put to death the deeds of the flesh?

- 1. Repent
- 2. Renew
- 3. Resist
