## Understanding Israel Romans 9:1-5 (NASV)

"What then shall we say to these things?" (Ro 8:31a)

- *Question:* Why was the Apostle Paul so interested in the Jewish people? (Two reasons)
- 1. He had a <u>personal</u> reason because he was <u>Jewish</u>. (v. 1-3)
- 2. He had a <u>prophetic</u> reason because through the writings of the <u>Old Testament</u> and through the inspiration of the <u>Holy Spirit</u> showed Paul that God has a <u>plan</u> and a <u>purpose</u> and He is going to keep His <u>promise</u> to the nation of Israel.

## Important Notes Concerning Israel:

- 1. It's the geographical center of the world. (Ezekiel 5:5)
- 2. It's the <u>religious</u> center of the world.
- 3. It's the political center of the world.
- 4. It's the prophetic center of the world.
- 5. It will one day be the <u>spiritual</u> center of the world.

## Background Knowledge of Israel.

- 1. The gifts God gave to Israel. (v.4)
  - God gave Israel a <u>Land</u>.
  - God gave Israel a <u>Law</u>.
  - God gave Israel a Language.
  - God gave Israel a <u>Lord</u>.
- 2. The <u>promises</u> God <u>made</u> to Israel (v.4)

- God made an everlasting covenant with the father of the Hebrew nation, Abraham. (Gen 17:7,8)

- 3. The <u>problems</u> for the nation of Israel.
  - <u>Desolation</u> (Leviticus 26:31-32)
  - Dissemination (Leviticus 26:33)
  - Division (Genesis 17:18-20)
  - Deception (Daniel 9:27)
- 4. God's <u>plan</u> for the nation of Israel. (Two words)
  - <u>Restoration</u> (Is 11:11,12); Ezekiel 37:21,22; Ez 39:25-29; Amos 9:14,15)
  - <u>Salvation</u> (Zech 12:10-; Ro 11:25-27)
