"It Is What It Is" Romans 9:19-29

Predestination (Two Parts)
"pre" means before
"destination" means point of final arrival

Predestination means that God <u>chooses</u> who will be <u>saved</u> and <u>determines</u> in <u>advance</u> that their final destination will be heaven.

Three answers Concerning Divine Sovereignty and Election:

1. God is God and He has the right to do whatever He wants. (Ro 9:19-21)

<sup>19</sup> You will say to me then, "Why does He still find fault? For who resists His will?" <sup>20</sup> On the contrary, who are you, O man, who answers back to God? The thing molded will not say to the molder, "Why did you make me like this," will it? <sup>21</sup> Or does not the potter have a right over the clay, to make from the same lump one vessel for honorable use and another for common use?

- 2. God <u>delays</u> His <u>wrath</u> to some in order to show His <u>mercy</u> to others. (Ro 9:22-23)
- 3. God has <u>chosen</u> to show <u>mercy</u> to both <u>Jews</u> and <u>Gentiles</u>. (Ro 9:24-29)
