“Drink offering:” - It’s a word that refers to the offering of the sacrifice at the end of the sacrifice to culminate the entire sacrificial event.

What was Paul’s “drink offering”? Paul’s “drink offering” was die for Christ.

Question: What does the word “departure” mean?

It’s a word used for loosening the mooring ropes of a ship. It was a term used for death.

Three Reasons Why Paul was Ready for His Departure:

1. He fought the good fight. (v.7a)

“Fight” is an athletic term from which we get the word agonize.

2. He finished the course. (v.7b)

The word “course” refers to the running of a race.

3. He kept the faith. (v.7c)

“The faith” was always a reference to the scripture.
