Principles Concerning the Lord's Supper 1 Corinthians 11:23-34

Principle #1: The Lord's Supper is a time of <u>commemoration</u>. (v. 24-25)

Principle #2: The Lord's Supper is a time of <u>appreciation</u>. (v. 24a)

Principle #3: The Lord's Supper is a time of <u>proclamation</u>. (v. 26)

Principle #4: The Lord's Supper is a time of <u>examination</u>. (v. 27-28)

Two things qualify you to take the Lord's Supper:

- 1. You have <u>turned</u> from your <u>sin</u> and <u>received Jesus Christ</u> as the Lord and Savior of your life.
- 2. You are willing to be <u>honest</u> with any <u>sin</u> in your life and <u>confess</u> it to the Father.

How do you do that?

- 1. <u>Identify it</u> you ask God before you take the Lord's Supper—Is there any sin in my life that I need to get corrected?
- 2. <u>Rectify it</u> confess it and admit it—ask forgiveness for it.
- 3. <u>Purify it</u> make sure that your heart is clean before the Lord.

Principle #5: The Lord's Supper is a time of <u>consideration</u>. (v. 33)

Principle #6: The Lord's Supper is a time of <u>anticipation</u>. (v.26)
