

The Danger of Compromise **Judges 14:1-20**

Compromise #1: He went to a place he never should have gone. (v.1a)

Compromise #2: He was looking for the wrong kind of relationship. (v.1-3)

Compromise #3: He rejected godly counsel from his parents. (v.3)

Compromise #4: He continues his downward spiral by breaking parts of his Nazirite vow to the Lord. (v. 5-10)

Compromise #5: He refused to admit that he had a weakness with lust and consequently never came to grips with it. (v. 11-17)

Compromise #6: He allows his emotions to get the best of him. (v. 18-20)

Life Application:

1. We need to be completely honest with ourselves concerning our weaknesses.
2. We need to anchor ourselves to the truth of God's Word and not compromise.
3. We need to be both empowered and controlled by the Holy Spirit.
