The Question of Origin Genesis 1:1-3

Who am I and how did I get here?

Point #1: We live in a world created by God. (Gen 1:1)

Reasons why this fits scientifically and philosophically:

1. Science and cosmology now admit that matter is <u>not eternal</u>. The universe has <u>not always</u> existed. It began at a <u>finite</u> period of time.

Two conclusions of science:

a. The universe had a beginning.

(Scientists believe the <u>Big Bang</u> was the beginning.)

- b. Whatever has a beginning has a cause.
- 2. There are some unbelievably <u>staggering "coincidence</u>" that make the universe fit for life.

Note: Science wants us to believe that this universe just accidentally exploded into existence perfectly!

3. Life cannot arise spontaneously by random natural forces from <u>nothing</u>.

Note: There is absolutely <u>no evidence</u> of <u>spontaneous generation</u> (i.e. that living organisms develop from non-living matter)

Note: Only <u>life</u> produces <u>life</u>.

Point #2: We live in a world controlled by God. (Gen 1:2,3)

NOTE: We are a creation of God living under His <u>sovereign control</u> and this God has a purpose and a plan.

Point #3: We live in a world where we can be <u>connected</u> to God. (Gen 1:26)
