## "The Evil of Favoritism in the Church" James 2:1-13 May 4, 2014

James' exhortation to the church: Do not be guilty of the sin of <u>showing</u> favoritism. (v.1)

## Why? Two reasons:

- 1. Favoritism is inconsistent with the Christian faith. (v.1)
- 2. Favoritism is inconsistent with Christ Himself. (v.1)

Two major mistakes the church made in verses 2-4:

- 1. They made the mistake of showing favoritism based on <u>outward</u> <u>appearance</u>.
- 2. They made the mistake of showing favoritism based on <u>socioeconomic</u> status.

The contradiction of verses 5-7: If the poor are so <u>important</u> to the Lord, how can they be so <u>unimportant</u> to us?

Three warnings to a church showing favoritism:

Warning #1: Showing favoritism violates the <u>royal law</u> of God.

(v. 8-9)

Warning #2: Showing favoritism makes a person guilty of the whole law of God. (v.10)

Warning #3: Showing favoritism is just as <u>serious</u> a sin as adultery and murder in God's eyes. (v.11)

## Two judgments in scripture:

- 1. The judgment of <u>unbelievers</u>. (Revelation 20:11-15)
- 2. The judgment of believers. (James 2:12; I Cor. 3)

James offers the church two applications:

- 1. Let the <u>scriptures</u> be your standard. (v.12,13)
- 2. Let love be your <u>law</u>. (v.8-13)
